## COMMANDANT'S DIRECTIVE

Directive No. 14-1

Promulgated June 10, 2014

## MARINE CORPS LEAGUE POLITICAL INVOLVEMENT

It is hereby directed that all members be reminded and follow the National ByLaws, Administrative Procedures Chapter One, Section 110, to wit:

## Section 110 - POLICY

(b) The Marine Corps League shall never take part in any labor or management dispute or issue, and it shall be ever <u>non-sectarian</u>, <u>non-political</u>; nor shall it be based on the grounds of race, color, creed, nationality, or sex; nor shall it be used as a medium of political ambition or preferment; nor shall former military rank or former or present civilian position be used as the basis for special consideration or preferment.

(c) Nothing in the preceding subsection shall prohibit the Marine Corps League or any subdivision thereof, from participating in political issues affecting the welfare of the United States Marine Corps, the national security of our Nation, or any veterans' claims for justice arising from service in the Armed Forces of the United States of America.
